## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WISLaw / SLA ALLIANCE

Purpose	WisLaw is an international, non-profit association based in Switzerland aimed at promoting, and raising awareness of, women in the sports law sector through scientific and networking events, annual meetings, gender equality championship - contest and annual reports on the participation of women in sports law positions.	
	SLA is the premier non-profit sports law professional association based in the United States of America whose common goal is the understanding, advancement, and ethical practice of sports law and providing networking and other benefits to its members.	
	WisLaw and SLA wish to work together to pursue a mutually beneficial alliance between their respective organizations and to advance the development of sports law internationally.	
	This MOU seeks to formalise the intentions and understandings of the parties in relation to such an alliance.	
Term	The alliance is ongoing from the date of execution of this MOU but either party may end the alliance, with or without cause, by providing 30 days written notice to the other party.	
Nature of alliance	During the term of the alliance, the parties will explore and, where appropriate, pursue activities that are of benefit to their respective organizations and members.	
	Without limiting the scope of the activities that may be undertaken during the term of the alliance, the parties will:	
	• <b>promote key events:</b> upon request, undertake appropriate promotion of key events undertaken of the other organisation by way of social media platforms, newsletters and/or electronic mails (for example, WisLaw promoting the SLA annual conference via its electronic communications to members, and vice versa);	
	• <b>joint regional functions:</b> explore opportunities to conduct joint regional functions. The details for these events will be determined on an event by event basis, but the intention is that the parties will work together i) to ensure speakers and ii) that members of the nonhosting organisation can attend the event for no or low cost, no more expensive that the cost for the members of the respective organisation;	
	annual conference attendance rates for members: each     organisation will offer the other organisation's members the

	opportunity to attend its annual conferences at the same rates applicable to the members of the organisation conducting the conference; and		
	• <b>website links:</b> each organisation will place on its website the logo of and a link to the webpage of the other organisation, where appropriate.		
Intellectual Property	Except as specifically set forth herein, the parties must ensure that if they wish to use the intellectual property of the other party (such as an organisation's name or logo) they first seek the written consent of the other party.

	or such other person or persons nominated and notified by the respective organisation from time to time.		
Termination	On the effective date of termination of the alliance, the parties must immediately cease promoting the alliance and cease using all materials bearing the other party's branding, name or logo.		
Relationship of	No joint venture, agency or partnership shall exist between the parties.		
parties	Neither party has the authority to contractually bind the other party without its express written approval.		
Not legally binding	No legally binding and enforceable obligations, including financial obligations, arise between the parties as a result of them signing this MOU other than their agreement not to use the other's intellectual property without prior written consent.
